Over the past twenty years, investment in primary resource production has grown worldwide. Scholarship of resource conflicts has followed, and we know quite a bit now about the factors that drive these conflicts and the character of collective movements to challenge these industries; however, this Special Issue takes up three limitations to this scholarship.

First, the literature is somewhat contained within disciplinary boundaries. We seek manuscripts that bring disciplinary/conceptual/methodological and literature-specific themes to the fore to begin to think through how scholars might harness the strengths interdisciplinary approaches. Topics within this rubric might include:

- Case studies/reflections on methodological approaches to studying resources industries and conflicts;
- Reviews of the literature within certain disciplinary or cross-disciplinary parameters;
- Conceptual and theoretical approaches to thinking through resource industries and conflicts.
