UNIVERSITY RECTORY RESOLUTION 221/2015, OF JULY 21, 2015.

Regulates the granting of a fellowship to the winner of the Paulo Freire Education Award in recognition of the best paper presented at LASA- Latin American Studies Association in 2016.

The Rector of Centro Universitário La Salle, under the provisions in Article 17 of the Bylaws of Centro Universitário La Salle, an institution accredited by the Brazilian Ministry of Education and Sports via the Decree dated December 29, 1998, published in the Brazilian Official Gazette on December 30, 1998, and re-accredited by Ordinance 626 of May 17, 2012, published in the Brazilian Official Gazette on May 18, 2012,

DECIDES

Art. 1- Approve and introduce the regulations necessary for granting a fellowship to the winner of the “Paulo Freire Education Award” presented by LASA, the Latin American Studies Association (University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, PA 15260, the US), at LASA’s discretion and according to its own criteria, in 2015.

Paragraph 1. The award mentioned in the caption is a fellowship to a sandwich doctoral program offered by Unilasalle’s Graduate Program in Education.

Paragraph 2. The fellowship hereunder includes solely enrollment and tuition costs related to Unilasalle’s Doctoral Program in Education, and therefore excludes expenses with any type of financial aid, transportation, housing, personal insurance, meals, and other occasional personal expenses.

Art. 2 – Applications for the fellowship granted by means of this Resolution may be filed until December 31, 2016.

Sole paragraph. In the event no formal applications are filed by the deadline above, the fellowship will be cancelled.

Art. 3 – Under this Resolution, the award process is in no way related to sweepstakes, lottery, or procedures that depend on “luck.”

Art. 4 – The “Paulo Freire Education Award” results will be announced by the LASA 2016 Section of Education and Educational Policies at the Welcome Reception, where the author of the winning paper will be publicly honored according to the event’s rules.

Sole paragraph. Unilasalle will not be responsible for the regulations related to the “Paulo Freire Education Award” participation, registration, or grant regulations, which are set by the Section of Education and Educational Policies of LASA – the Latin American Studies Association.



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Art. 5 – For purposes of this resolution, the “Paulo Freire Education Award” winning applicant approved in the selection process must:

Paragraph 1. Enroll in the respective program under the Institutional Agreement between the doctoral program in the applicant’s/candidate’s country of origin and Unilasalle’s Graduate Program in Education;

Paragraph 2. Candidates will not be allowed to change programs or advisors after enrolling;

Paragraph 3. The fellowship will be automatically cancelled in the event the doctoral candidate requests a leave of absence from the program or a course, and the fellow will be required to pay the occasional tuition yet to become due within the period agreed upon for the fellowship;

Paragraph 4. In case courses are offered at another Brazilian or international school, the respective costs will not be covered by the award.

Art. 6 – Cases not provided for herein will be settled by the Office of the University Rector, according to Centro Universitário La Salle’s Bylaws and the legislation in force.
